

FACILITIES AND EQUIPMENT

The Pueblo campus occupies approximately 16,000 square feet of newly renovated and updated space at a convenient location. The campus features bright, spacious classrooms, laboratories for all pro-grams, a reference library and ample parking.

The entire facility is centrally heated and air conditioned; decorated and furnished throughout to enhance the student's environment and achieve a quality learning atmosphere.

Classroom equipment is modern and includes extensive selections of visual aids and 48 computer systems running Windows 7 and Microsoft Office 2007.

Massage Therapists train in a lab and working clinic environment that features both portable and stationary massage tables and accessories, massage chairs, a complete set of lotions and oils, aromatherapy supplies, linens and towels, bolsters, assorted videotapes, and a laundry.

Medical Assistant students will be prepared in a classroom and clinical lab environment equipped with syringes, needles, a centrifuge, a microhematocrit, glucometers, EKG machines, exam tables, a spirometer, an autoclave, a sedimentation rate rack, a hemoglobin meter, anatomy charts, Stedman's Medical Dictionary, Physician's Desk References, gram stain supplies, microscopes, oto scopes, sphygmomanometers, stethoscopes, an incubator, a baby scale, an adult scale, and a refrigerator.

The Dental Assistant program offers students three fully operational treatment rooms (i.e. dental chair and unit, light and suctioning hand pieces), one dental X-ray machine, an automatic X-ray processor/-developer unit, two composite curing light devices, an amalgamator, an ultrasonic machine, an autoclave, a study model trimmer, two lab vibrators, buffing and polishing wheels, a vacuum former, two X-ray viewing boxes, high speed hand pieces, a compressor system, a vacuum system, and a computer system with printer.

Cosmetology instruction is taught primarily at the 3691 Parker Blvd. building, adjacent to the main Pueblo campus building. The space is in a newly constructed building which occupies 3000 square feet. This space has been specially designed from the ground up for a modern full service cosmetology school and salon. The equipment includes 36 hi-tech custom styling stations, state-of the-art hair washing stations, 2 European Touch pedicure stations, 8 manicure stations, 2 esthetician rooms with electronic skin care systems, a color bar, dispensary/storage room, a laundry room and a locker room.

The Medical Administrative Technician students will train in a computerized classroom that is equipped with the most current and up-to-date office equipment and medical software as preparation for introduction to a medical working environment.
